As we announced at our wine tasting fundraiser and in our previous newsletter, we are pleased to be co-funding the Child Life Specialist Fellowship position at St. Christopher's Hospital. The new Fellow has been selected and will begin her fellowship on January 1, 2012. Congratulations Karlyn Bender! We have already funded \$11,000 to the Fellowship and have committed to an additional \$11,000 by the conclusion of her year. One of the main responsibilities of this position is to offer support to the Special Care and Burn Unit of the Hospital. This amazing position provides services such as dressing changes, treatment room interventions, therapeutic play sessions, support groups and school reentry programs. The Fellow also works with the burn team providing education in the hospital and community. In addition, her final project will be a public awareness campaign specifically related to burn prevention!
